





Private jail discussion sparks impact fee talks

It appears that Santa Rosa County will be getting a private jail to complement the existing county jail.

But the discussion surrounding a proposed private jail project also sparked a request for special workshops and investigation into the impact fees being charged by local utilities, especially water companies, within the county.

Commissioners last week approved granting some incentives in tax breaks and providing some infrastructure to a company called GEO, which builds large private prisons. The project called Project Justice would be a 2,000-bed prison on 125 acres adjacent to 160 acres owned by the county just north of the county's industrial park and near the current county jail.

Commissioner Don Salter, chairman of the county's economic development committee, has been working with the City of Milton to get tax breaks for tap fees and impact fees for this project for several weeks.

proposed new jail would not take prisoners away from Sheriff Wendell Hall's jail.

County Attorney Tom Dannheiser said prisoners in the private jail would be different than Hall's.

Salter explained, "I have already talked with Sheriff Hall about this, and he assures me these are different prisoners than he handles. He handles prisoners that are pre-trial holds. These prisoners would be already sentenced inmates. This facility will be about a half-mile down the road from the county jail."

Commissioners approved what would be needed to move Project Justice ahead.

But during the discussion, Commissioner Gordon Goodin said this is an example of how suddenly utilities and the City of Milton can cut tap fees if they feel it is justified.

"We had some utilities stand right here before us a few months ago and say to us that they charge what the market bears, not necessarily the actual fees it takes to operate and hook somebody up," Goodin said. "I think that is a problem for economic development. I think the time is perfect for these utilities where we grant franchises to justify their impact or tap fees."

"There are three utilities I know of within the county right now that cannot sell their taps right now. Economic development in those areas is down. They are using their reserves to pay their employees. So all those fees must have brought in some extra money for some time. I think we need to hold some discussions and some workshops on that, and soon."
