





Proposed impact fees, projects topics of Dewey-Humboldt meeting Tuesday

The Dewey-Humboldt Town Council and the municipality's ad hoc Capital Improvement Program Committee will conduct a joint meeting this week for a public hearing on the town's proposed development impact fees.

Tuesday at 3 p.m. inside Town Hall, 2735 S. Highway 69, the CIP Committee also will give a preliminary review of the proposed and existing infrastructure projects it is looking at recommending to the council for its approval.

Council members will weigh in on the projects they would like to see move forward while making suggestions about ones they think the town should delay for the time-being.

After the discussions on the proposed impact fees and CIP projects, council will take additional comments from the public.

On Nov. 17, council expects to vote on a development impact fee ordinance, more than a month after hearing public comments about the issue.

If approved the fees would become effective on Feb. 1, 2010.
