Supervisors cut fee for Nipomo church

Compromise on road impact fee

A Nipomo church seeking to reduce its road impact fee saw its prayers partially answered Tuesday.

The county Board of Supervisors lopped nearly one-third off the \$15,000 fee the Department of Public Works had sought to extract from the Nipomo Community Presbyterian Church as part of the church's application to build a new sanctuary.

The county reduced the fee to \$10,982, according to development services engineer Richard Marshall of the Public Works Department, who suggested the compromise and later worked out the exact amount, using a complicated formula.

Supervisor Chairman Katcho Achadjian, in whose district the church sits, had asked for a reduction to \$2,500 and voted against the higher number.
