Eagle Lake to consider waiving some impact fees

EAGLE LAKE - During its scheduled Monday meeting, the Eagle Lake City Commission will consider waiving impact fees for construction and redevelopment within the city's designated core improvement area.

If passed on second reading, the impact fee-related ordinance should jump start business development in the Community Redevelopment Area by giving the city a bargaining tool to attract new businesses to that area, city officials said.

In other business, the commission is expected to:

Consider the first reading of an ordinance to amend the Eagle Lake Code of Ordinances and Land Development Code to include the Eagle Lake Community Redevelopment Area Site and Building Design Standards and Guidelines.

Consider a resolution to authorize the city manager and mayor to take all action necessary and appropriate action to apply for funding help for the city's water meter replacement project.

The commission meeting is scheduled for 7 p.m. at Eagle Lake City Hall.




