Hamilton Twp. looks into cost of developing park

It would be on more than 200 acres off Stubbs Mill Road.

Hamilton Twp. trustees authorized Community Development Director Gary Boeres earlier this month to continue looking into the cost of developing a park, off Stubbs Mill Road.

"If we're going to look at it further, then I think people should know what we're doing," Trustee Gene Duvelius said.

In December, a small committee interviewed three companies based on their qualifications and chose CDS Associates as their first pick. Now the township is moving forward to have a scope of services created for improvements and a master plan.

"We're just going to talk to CDS, but if their fee or the services are too much, then we can go to the second firm." Boeres said.

This is the first step in developing the park that would sit on more than 200 acres. However, nothing firm has been decided. Besides the possibility of having a fishing lake, trustees previously said amenities ranging from a camping area and miniature golf to a banquet facility and ball diamonds could be additions researched for the future.
