Impact fee debate shifts to commercial development

Polk County commissioners heard more about the evils of impact fees Wednesday. This time the issue was whether Polk County's impact fees are a deterrent to commercial development that was chasing new development - in this case an unnamed restaurant chain - to other Central Florida counties where impact fees are lower.

The majority of the commission appeared to buy the argument and will be discussing the issue in more detail at a work session next month, saying they were concerned that they didn't want to put unnecessary barriers to job growth and economic development.

Commissioner Bob English was skeptical, questioning whether impact fees were the deciding factor in determing whether to locate in Polk County, trumping land costs, property taxes or any other development-related costs.
